

I Michael Doll and Being in perfect Health and Memory do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following

Item.

I give Devise and Bequeath unto my Wife Judith Doll and to her Heirs for ever light Hundred acres Land whereon Emethy Osedale now lives in Louisa County. I also give unto my said Wife during her Natural life light Hundred acres Land on Sinkinghole Creek with two plantations thereon and the Use of the Stocks of cattle and Hogs and all my Household goods for her own support and not to sell, as also the Use Benefitt and proffit of the Labour of the six following Negroes Frank, Pompey, Will, Alan, Dennis & Moll, which Negroes after her Decease I will Direct and Appoint to be sold by my Executors and the Money Equally divided Betwixt the Children of my Son John when they arrive at Age or Married.

Item.

I give Devise a Bequeath to my Son John Doll and to his Heirs for ever after the said Judith my Wifes Death the aforesaid light Hundred acres Land on Sinkinghole Creek with the two plantations thereon and the Stocks of cattle and hogs likewise a Negro Woman Named Sager & her three Children and

the two plantations Merdon and the stocks of cattle and hogs
likewise a Negro Woman Named Dagee her three children and
Daniel.

Item. I give Devise and Bequeath unto my Son Richard Dollan
and to his heirs forever four hundred acres of land lying in Louisa
County which I bought of Laddock and fifty pounds for money
to be paid eighteen Months after my Death.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my Son in Law Pompey Anderson
and to his heirs forever four hundred acres land on Licking hole
creek which he now has in possession also five hundred acres
land adjacent thereto two hundred acres I bought of W. Owen
and the land lying between Owens and Potters being one hundred
and fifty six acres and as much more joining Owens as will
make up the five hundred acres. Also I give my said Son in Law
two Negro's which he now has in possession Thom and David
likewise I give him Sampshire and his Wife called Judith and
their two children Venus and Roger.

Item. I give Devise and Bequeath unto my Sons Richard
Dollan and two his heirs forever a plantation lying in
Louisa County which I bought of Ambrose Smith also a plantation
called Meridiths Branch in the

County which I bought of Laddock and fifty pounds for Attorney
to be paid Eighteen Months after my Death.

Item. I Give and Bequeath to my Son in Law Pompey Anderson
and to his Heirs forever four Hundred Acres Land on Lickinghole
Creek which he now has in Possession Also five Hundred Acres
Land adjacent thereto two Hundred Acres I bought of W^m Owen
and the Land lying Between Owens and Potters being one hundred
and fifty six Acres and as much more Joining Owens as will
make up the five Hundred. Also I Give my said Son in Law
two Negroes which he now has in Possession Thome and David
likewise I Give him Damphire and his Wife called Judith and
their two Children Vanns. and Roger.

Item. I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Richard
Holland and to his Heirs forever a Plantation lying in
Louisa Count^y which I bought of Ambrose Smith. Also a Plantation
called Meridiths Branch in Service County whereon he now
lives containing five Hundred Acres Land and four Hundred
and fifty Acres Land I Promise to Give him Joining thereto where
on W^m Webb formerly lived. Also I Give him the following Negroes

Danny, Alan, Robin, Sarah, and two of her children and a Negro Boy called Jimmy and fifty pounds Curr. Money to be paid Eighteen Month after my Death.

I give Deeds and Bona fide to my Son George Holland and to his heirs forever Seven Hundred Acres Land in Louisa County which I bought of Cap. Sanjo One Hundred Acres Land which I bought of John Moor one Hundred and fifty Acres Land which I bought of Douglas. and in Law of five Hundred Acres Land I Promise my said Son on Lickinghole I give him four Hundred Acres Land saying the Land I bought of Douglas I also give my said Son the following Slaves, King, Lucy, and their two children, Betty and Silby and a Negro Girl called Leah and Jack and his Wife called Peg, Likewise two feather Beds and furniture and all the other Household Goods which is on the S. Plantation where on he now lives Likewise Twenty head Cattle and two Horses named Spark and Jack and one half the Dogs on the S. Plantation and two Breeding Mares, all the above mentioned Articles Land, Slaves, Stock and Household Goods and all other Appurtenances here in Mentioned I give to my Son George in consideration of a Promise

the said Martins own Land Likewise I Give to my said Son in Law
fifty Acres Land Lying in Dane County on the Right Side the Road
going down the country and about half a Mile Below the Planta-
tion whereon I live Likewise the following Slaves viz. Cook, Sue, Sarah
and their Child named Sue Likewise a Girl called Sue and a fellow
named Bristol the five fore Mentioned Slaves now in his Possession
Likewise I Give to my said Son in Law fifty pounds Curr. money to be
paid Eighteen Months after my Death.

Item. I Give Give and Bequeath to my Daughters Anne Infan-
na and Mary to each of them four Hundred Pounds Curr. money
two Hundred Pounds to be paid when of age or Married and
the balance to be paid at ten years after and if either of them

I give Devise and Bequeath to my Son in Law Henry Martin

the said Martins own Land Likewise I give to my said Son in Law
fifty acres Land Lying in Ware County on the Right Side the Road
going down the County and about half a Mile Below the Planta-
tion whereon I live Likewise the following Slaves viz. Cook, Sus, Sarah
and their Child named Sus Likewise a Girl called Sus and a fellow
named Bristol the five fore Mentioned Slaves now in his possession
Likewise I give to my said Son in Law fifty pounds Curr. money to be
paid Eighteen Months after my Death.

Item.

I give Devise and Bequeath to my Daughters Anne Infan-
na and Marcy to each of them four Hundred Pounds Curr. money
two Hundred Pounds to be paid when of Age or Married and
two Hundred Pounds to be paid two years after and if either of them
shall dye before they are of Age or Married then their other part or
parts of such money to be equally divided Between the Children of

224. my sons Michael and Richard Holland. I likewise give to my Daughter Anne a Negro Girl named Ann, to my Daughter Susannah a Negro Girl named Patt. to my Daughter Mercy a Negro Girl named Lucy.

Item.

all the Rest of my Land Negro's and Personall Estate not before mentioned I Will Direct and apoint to be sold By my Executors Henry Martin, Pouncey Anderson, Rich. Holland and the Money to be applyed towards the Payment of my Debts and Legacies and Maintaining my Daughters Anne Susanna and Mercy the Residue when all the Land Negro's and Personall Estate shall be sold I give to be Equally Divided Among my sons John Michael Richard, George and my Daughters Eliz. Anderson and Judith Martin.

Item.

The next Profits of my Estate Between my Death and the Sale thereof I Will and Direct shall be applyed to the Uses aforesaid and also my Household goods After the Death of my Wife.

Item.

I Will and Direct that my Estate be not brought to any Appraisement.

Item.

I Apoint Henry Martin, Pouncey Anderson and Rich. Holland

Item. I appoint Henry Martin, Pompey Anderson and Rich^d Holland Guardians to my three Daughters Anne, Susanna and Mercy.

Item. I give to my Grandson Jⁿ. Holland Son of Jⁿ. Holland and his Andrews Acres Land in Orange County which I Bought of Jⁿ. Bryant.

Item. I do constitute and Apoint my Son in Law Henry Martin my Son in Law Pompey Anderson and my Sons Richard Holland to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament and do swear by Revokes all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 10th day Octob^r. 1746.
