Impairnis. I give my Negro man Peter to my Daughters Mary, Prudence,
Judith, and Edith, and it is my Will that the said Negro and my
Daughters aforesaid do remain and live together on the plantation
where I now live and that when any of them Marry their right to the
said Negro be void, and that those who remain unmarried have the
sole use of him without being answerable for any part of his Value,
and if all my said Daughters die or when they are all Married then
I give the said Negro to my Son Stephen Cox & his heirs for ever.

Item. I give my Negro Jenny to my said Daughters to remain with them
on the plantation and to work for them after the manner I have
directed Peter to be with them.

Item. I give my Negro Child Phoebe to my Daughter Edith & to her heirs
for ever.

Item. I give unto my Son Stephen a Silver Saltceller & tumbler.

Item. I give unto my Daughter Martha a Silver Porringer.

Item. I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth three new Plates

Item. I give unto my Daughter Mary my Oval Table & a black trunk.

Blanket and Sheets.

Item. I give unto my Granddaughter Magdalene Burton the bed and
furniture on which I lie.

Item. all the rest of my Estate I give to be equally divided between my
Daughters Mary, Prudence, Edith and Judith, except my wearing
Apparell which I give to my Daughter Elizabeth.

Lastly I make Henry Wood my Executor and direct that my Estate be
not Appraised. Witness my hand and Seal the 29th day of March
1726.

At a Court held for Goochland County Janry 20. 1727.
Henry Wood made Oath that he wrote the within Will at the Desire and
according to the Directions of Sarah Cox deceased, that he read the Will to
the said Sarah who approved put her mark and set her Seal to the same in
the presence of the said Henry that William Cox and John Taylor were
present and subscribed their Names as Witnesses to the said Will all
which on the motion of William Harding (who intermarried with Edith
one of the Daughters of the said Sarah) was ordered to be recorded.
