do make and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner and form  
as followeth.

Item I give unto my daughter Mary Darris, my Large book Cithed  
the Life & Death of the Holy Iesus, and my Still, and my Copper Kettle  
to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Ketherland my black Mare  
Saddle & Bridle, and one feather Bed and furniture to her and her heirs  
forever, and I likewise give her all the Debt that she oweth me.

Item I give unto my Son John Ketherland the young bay mare as he  
hath in Pofion with one feather Bed and furniture to him and his  
heirs forever.

Item I give to my Son Benjamin Ketherland the other young mare  
with a feather Bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give to my Grand Daughter Sarah Dankin Darris one Goud  
ring to the Value of twenty Shilling to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give unto each of my Daughters a Suit of mourning.

Item after all my Debts and Legacies are paid the rest of my Estate I  
leave to be sold & the money & smaller Goods my two Sons John

his forever.

Item I give to my Son Benjamin Ketherland the other young man with a feather Bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give to my Grand Daughter Sarah Rankin Harris one hundred ring to the Value of twenty Shilling to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give unto each of my Daughters a Suit of mourning

Item after all my Debts and Legacies are paid the rest of my Estate I leave to be sold and the money Equally divided my two Sons John & Benjamin to them and there heirs forever.

I constitute and Appoint my Son Wade Ketherland & John Ketherland Exec. to this my Last Will and Testament revoking all other by me made before In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty six day Jan<sup>ry</sup>. one thousand seven hundred & forty six

At a Court hold for Yorkland County March 10. 1745.  
This Writing was Proved by the Oath of Thomas Edwards to be the last

Will and Testament of Sarah Ketherland Deceased and it was thereupon admitted to Record.

This Indenture made this Seventeenth Day of March  
 1749 Between Henry Ketherham of the County of Goochland  
 and Parish of Southham of the one part and William Moss Junior  
 of the same County and Parish of the other part Witnesseth That the  
 said Henry Ketherham for and in consideration of the sum of eighty  
 pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said  
 William Moss before the Sealing and Delivering of these presents  
 the Receipt whereof he the said Henry Ketherham doth hereby ac-  
 knowledge hath given granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed &  
 confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien  
 Enfeoff and confirm unto the said William Moss Junior his heirs  
 and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying in  
 the County and Parish of Southham
