being sick and weak and in good sense and memory thanks be
to God for it I do make this my last will and testament in manner
and order following. I give and bequeath to my beloved son
Thomas Lorkett two hundred Acres of land in Amelia County on
fallin Creek beginning at the plant park to him and his heirs
for ever the other two hundred acres he purchased of Edward
Darris it being my Entry. Item I give and bequeath to my
beloved Son Joel all the land I now hold on the north side of
butterwood Creek excepting four Acres below the bridge to him his
heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son Gideon
the major plantation whereon I now live and four Acres on the
north side of the said Creek below the bridge to him and his heirs
for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son in law
Daryn Allday one hundred acres of Land being near Skin Quar-
ter Creek joining Mossley and Worley and also one cow and
calf to him and his heirs for ever. Item. I give and bequeath
to my beloved Daughter Hannah all the rest of my Land on or
near Skin Quarter to her heirs for ever I give Hannah two cows
one horse and saddle the same to be delivered to her

butterwood Creek excepting four Acres below the bridge to him his
heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son Gideon
the maize plantation whereon I now live and four Acres on the
north side of the said Creek below the bridge to him and his heirs
forever. Item I give and bequeath to my beloved son in law
Daryn Allday one hundred acres of Land being near Skin Quar-
ter Creek adjoining McCoskey and Worley and also one cow and
calf to him and his heirs for ever. Item. I give and bequeath
to my beloved Daughter Hannah all the rest of my Land on or
near Skin Quarter to her heirs for ever I give Hannah two cows
one horse and Saddle the horse is to be between five and ten year
old. I give Lucy one cow and calf and I give to my Wife six cattle
and the rest of the stock to be divided between Joel and Gideon
and all the household goods onely one bed for my daughter
Hannah lastly I institute and appoint Joel Lockett Arthur
McCoskey and Good Joskins executors of this my last will and
testament to which I have set my hand and fixed my Seal
Fifteenth day of November in the year of our Lord Christ 1745.

do make and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner and form
as followeth.

Item I give unto my daughter Mary Darris, my large book tithed
the Life & Death of the Holy Jesus, and my still, and my Copper Kettle
to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Ketherland my black Mare
Saddle & Bridle, and one feather bed and furniture, to her and her heirs
forever, and I likewise give her all the Debt that she oweth me.
