and Memory I do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament
in manner and form as followeth. Item I give to my Son William Dillon
one hundred and fifty acres of Land at the upper part of the Land that I
now possess and dwell on joining Col^l Benjamin Harrison line to be laid
off in an Equitable manner Item I give to my Son Henry Dillon one hun-
dred and fifty acres of Land with the plantation whereon I now dwell to
him and his heirs. Item I give to my Grandson James Dillon one hundred
acres of Land to him and his heirs lawfully begotten of his Body and
in case my Grandson James Dillon die without such heir as aforesaid
my desire is that my Grandson William Sammon sh^l have the said
hundred acres of Land given to my aforesaid Grandson James Dillon. Item
I lend to my Loving Wife Mary Dillon all my personal Estate of all
sorts and kinds whatsoever with the plantation whereon I now
dwell during her Natural life. Item my desire is th^t after the Decease
of my said Wife Mary Dillon the personal Estate sh^l be equally divi-
ded between my ^{two} Sons William Dillon and Henry Dillon and my two
Daughters Sarah Dillon and Judith Dillon. Item I constitute make and
appoint my said Wife Mary Dillon and my said Son William Dillon
Executors of this my will.

I send to my loving Wife Mary Dillon all my personal Estate of all
Sorts and kinds whatsoever with the plantation whereon I now
dwell during her Natural life. Item my desire is that after the Deaths
of my said Wife Mary Dillon the personal Estate she be equally divi-
ded between my two Sons William Dillon and Henry Dillon and my two
Daughters Sarah Dillon and Indath Dillon. Item I constitute make and
appoint my said Wife Mary Dillon and my said Son William Dillon
Executors Item I William Dillon desire the Estate not to be appraised
of this my Last will and Testament witness my hand and Seal this 27th
day of September one Thousand seven hundred thirty and nine
