St James in the County of Goodland being of perfect and sound mind
and memory do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testa-
ment in manner and form following. First I commend my Soul to
God and commit my Body to y^e Earth to be decently buried at the
discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as to my worldly
estate I give and bequeath as followeth.

Item. I will that all my Debts and funeral charges b^ep. and defrayed
Item. I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas Farrar 1 pⁱ. Pistols and
Sword one sword to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my Son William Farrar one Negro girl
called Phoebe with a lincloth to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give unto my Son John Farrar one Negro boy called Peter
to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I leave unto my loving Wife Sarah Farrar during her Widowhood
all my estate one Negro Woman called Anna and one Negro

girl called Sarah and one Negro girl called Tenny, and my Will is
that after the decease of my said Wife Mary, said Negroes wth their
increase be equally divided between my two sons Sarah Farrar
and Perrin Farrar to them and their heirs fore.

All the rest of my personal Estate not already bequeathed I lend unto
my loving Wife Sarah Farrar during her natural life and after
her decease to be equally divided amongst my four Sons William
Farrar, Richard Farrar, Joseph Farrar and Perrin Farrar; and I
do hereby appoint my two Sons Thomas Farrar and William Farrar
to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament revoking all
other wills by me heretofore made either by word of mouth or
writing In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my Seal this fourteenth Day of November Anno Dom. 1743.
