

In the name of God Amen I William Randolph of Henrico County Domains this
my last will & Testament in manner & form following, I recommend my Soul to
God, hoping through the Merits & Mediation of my blessed Saviour Jesus
Christ to receive pardon & remission of my sins. As to my Body I give it to be
disposed of & buried at the discretion of my Executors. Item I give & bequeath
unto my Daughter Mary, Eight Hundred Pounds Sterling & One Hundred
pounds current money, with a new Chair & Bairns for Six Horses which I
have sent for, together with Six Horses of her own choosing. Item I give
& devise unto my Son Peter Randolph & his heirs forever all my Land lying
at West Ham, not before given him, with Sixteen Negroes thereon. I also give
& devise to him & his heirs forever my tract of Land at a stalow in Goochland
County containing One Hundred & odd Acres with Seven Negroes belonging
thereto, as also all my Land at the fork of Appamattox that lyeth on the north
side of the river, not before given to his Brother Beverly Randolph, with
Seven Negroes belonging thereto. Item I give & devise unto my Son William
Randolph & his heirs forever all my Land lying on the Branches of Fighting
Creek in Goochland County containing Seven Thousand & Odd Acres with all
Negroes thereon except those hereon otherwise given. I also give him Two
Hundred & Fifty Pounds Sterling & One Hundred pounds current money.

Randolph plus heirs forever all my Land lying on the Branches of fighting
Creek in Goochland County containing Seven Thousand & Odd Acres with all
Negroes thereon except those hereinafter otherwise given. I also give unto
Negroes named Hercules & Isaac, Item I give unto Sarah Cobb for the life of
her Daughter One hundred pounds current money. I also give unto her
Daughter Sarah Stagg all my Land on the South side of Appamatox River
to be to her & the Heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever & for want of
such Heirs then to return to my Son William Randolph plus heirs forever
I also annex to the said Land for the uses aforementioned five negroes named
Lieuff Affeg Baguel Jack & Plubby. Item I give unto my Son Peter Randolph
two negroes named Jemmy & Flora all the Rest & residue of my Estate Real
& Personal I give unto my Son Berkeley plus heirs forever except as
followeth, I give unto my Daughter Mary five negroes named Plubby
Mistilla Phillis plus three children. I give unto my Son William Randolph
all my Plate & Household Goods on the Plantation where I live in Goochland
County. It is my Will that the Stock Cools & Utensils on the several Lands be
given therewith. It is also my Will that the Slaves & Plantations hereinafter
particularly given be kept together by my Executors until my Negroes
shall be paid out of the profits thereof. I also give Two Hundred pounds.

Stocking which is owing to me from my Son in Law John Cisswell into his Daughters Elizabeth & Susannah to be put out to Interest by my Executors for their use. Lastly I do Appoint my three Sons, Beverly Randolph Peter Randolph & William Randolph Executors of this my last Will & Testament, & it is my Direction that my Executors be not obliged to Inventory or appraise my Estate. Witness my Hand & Seal the Seventh south day of October One Thousand Seven hundred & forty two.
