the uncertain State of this human Life have thought fit to make this
my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. Viz.
I give my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it, in hopes of
a Joyfull and Blessed Resurrection and my Body to be Decently Buried
at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named.
I give and Bequeath unto my dear Daughter Judith Randolph Twelve
Hundred Pounds Sterling money; One Thousand Pounds Sterling of
which said Sum to be paid to her at the Day of her Marriage or when
she shall arrive to the Age of Twenty one Years; The other Two Hundred
Pounds Sterling who she shall be at the Age of Sixteen Years, shall
be to her use in such Cinketts as her Guardians shall think
fitt. I also give and Bequeath to my said Daughter Judith all the
Gold Jewels and other Cinketts which belonged to her mother my Dear
Deceased Wife, and Three Negro Girls such as she shall chuse out of my
whole Estate not breeding Sixteen Years of Age, to her the said Judith and

her heirs for ever.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my Dear Daughter Mary Randolph Twelve Hundred Pounds Sterling money. One thousand pounds Sterling of which said sum to be paid to her at the Day of her Marriage or when she shall arrive to the Age of Twenty one Years. The other Two hundred Pounds Sterling when she shall be at the Age of sixteen Years shall be laid out for her use in such Trunkets as her Guardians shall think fitt. I do also give and bequeath to my said Daughter Mary, Three Negro Girls such as she shall chuse out of my whole Estate not exceeding sixteen Years of Age to her the said Mary and her heirs forever. And my Will is that handsome and Decent Monuments be Erected by my Executors out of the Profits of my Estate to the Memory of Thomas Randolph my ever Honour'd Father and Dear and Loving Mother and to the Memory of my Dear and ever Loving Wife Mary Randolph.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my dear only Son Thomas Mann Randolph and his heirs for ever all the Remainder and Residue of my Estate both Real and Personal, all my Debts and Legacies being first paid, and my Will further is that my Son Thomas Mann Randolph
