Almonce of the Executor by leave to report that they have ascertained the amount which came into the hands of the said Executor to be \$1230.53 1/4 - that the payment made by him amounting to \$87.69 1/4 which being assumed and found to be supported by proper and legal evidence was allowed by your Commissioners. It is also the duty of your Commissioners to certify the amount of \$61.52 being a commission of 5 per centum on the amount of the estate which came into the hands of the Executor, and which your Commissioners considered a reasonable allowance. The balance remaining in the hands of the Executor for distribution under the will appears to be at this time \$412.84 and all which is respectfully reported
