in manner and form following, that is to say: 1st I desire that
all my lawful Debts and burial expenses be first paid, 2nd I give
and bequeath unto my eldest Daughter Ruth Warner (Daughter of my
former wife) one Dollar over and above what I have already given her
3rd I give unto my eldest son Nathan Cox (son of my former wife)
one dollar over and above what I have given him heretofore, 4th I give
unto my second son Valamer Cox (son of my former wife) one Dollar
over and above what I have given him heretofore, 5th I give unto my
third son Erumh Cox (son of my former wife) one Dollar over and above
what I have already given him, 6th I give unto my second daughter
Nelly Love Cox (Daughter of my former wife) ten dollars over and above
what I have given her heretofore, 7th I give unto fourth son Jesse
(Cox son of my former wife) one Dollar over and above what I have
given him heretofore, 8th I give unto fifth and last son of my former
or present wife two hundred acres of Land lying on the north east
part of the plantation on which I now live, including the house on
which the said Jeremiah Cox now resides over and above what I have given him
heretofore, 9th My will is that all my real and personal estate be
vested in the hands of my last wife Sally Cox and Mark D. Stoneman
man both my executor, and to be by them applied in the best and
most economical manner for raising and educating my last set of
children namely Joshua, Elizabeth, Mary and John Cox infant
children of my last wife Sally Cox 10th I request that no in-
ventory of my personal property be taken and appointed and tested
I do hereby constitute the above mentioned Sally Cox my wife and
Mark D. Stoneman executor of this my last will and testa-
ment revoking all other or former wills or testaments by me
heretofore made, the contents whereof I have heretofore set my hand
and affixed my seal this 21st of 3rd Mo. 1840.
