In obedience to an order of the County Court of Kingsport made at the August term of the said Court 1824 the undersigned a Commission appointed for that purpose (having been duly sworn has proceeded to settle and adjust the account of James Blair Sheriff's Executor of the said James Blair Sheriff and has cause to state that I have charged the

Conductors with the purpose and intent of what placed in his hands by said Court up to the 26th December 1824 and receipt and other papers delivered by same up to the 26th July 1822 the terms they came into said Blair's hands he is also charged with advance sums distributed by said Blair's Court and the balance in hands of said Blair's Court with interest from 26th July 1822 in which the whole that came into his hands for \$211.57 = his allowing the Executors credit for such sums as were required and advanced I have been governed by the vouchers produced, and in cases where no vouchers were produced incident claims have been allowed upon satisfactory evidence being produced to me. Credit was allowed for all sums distributed and disbursed, and interest has been allowed from the time of distribution and disbursement up to the 26th day of December 1824, to which period interest was charged on a portion of what came into his hands. (The sum of \$27.48 is properly charged to the estate of said Blair, as it forms an account item and is due as that he had received that sum in his life time (See on face of account). It will however be referred to the report of the Commission on record made out with said Blair's account to the effect that the balance of the distribution share of said Blair in right of his wife amount to the sum of \$1452.62 and if that sum is not reduced by incident debts and other charges against the estate, that then the said Blair will have the right to retain the same in his own hands. It also appears by vouchers filed with this report that several of the Distributes have received more than their distribution share as matters that will require further investigation as to the manner in which the foregoing is based see the account prepared to the account all of which is respectfully submitted January 29th 1825.
