In obedience to an order of the County Court of Grayson made at the
August term of the court 1824 the undersigned a Commissioner
appointed for that purpose having been duly sworn has presented to settle
and adjust the accounts of John Blair Surveyor of Roads
of Letcher and Boone counties and says cause to state that he has charged the

Commissioner with the principal and interest of debts placed in his hands by Blair from up to
the 26th December 1824 and certain amounts and other papers delivered by him up to
the 26th July 1822 the time they came into said Blair's hands. He is also charged with several
sums distributed by said Blair and the balance in hands of Blair from up to interest
from 26th July 1822 making the whole that comes into his hands \$211.49 = his allowing
the Commissioner credit for such sums as were equivalent and reasonable. It has been found by
the Commissioners products, and in case were no numbers were produced sufficient claims
have been allowed upon satisfactory evidence being produced to me. Credit was allowed
for all sums distributed and disbursed, and interest have been allowed from the time
of distribution and disbursement up to the 26th day of December 1824, to which period
interest was charged on a portion of what came into his hands. The sum of \$27.48 is
properly chargeable to the estate of Lewis Blair, as it grows out of his time and conduct.
That he has received that sum in his life time (See on face of account). It will however
by reference to the report of the Commissioner on account made out with Lewis Blair the
successor thereto, that the balance of the distributor's share of said Blair in right of his
wife amounts to the sum of \$1454.62. Part of that sum is not reduced by instant
debt and other charges against the estate, that then the said Blair will have the right
to act on the same in his own hands. It also appears by the report filed with this report that
several of the Distributors have received more than their distributor shares, a matter
that will require further investigation. As to the manner in which the foregoing is
fixed see the account prefixed to this account. All of which is respectfully submitted
January 29th 1825.
