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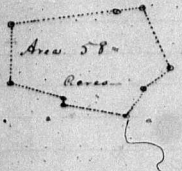

 Court. The following terms of the said Court 1848, and to be directed, against
 at the house of Peter Cines, widow of Joseph Cines dead on the 27th
 day of January 1848, and proceeded to lay off and apportion to the said
 her share in the land, and others of her said husband as follows. In the
 place assigned to the said her share one negro man secured from
