 and lastly I do here by constitute and appoint my wife Nancy Stone  
 executrix of this my last will and to execute here by executing all other or  
 former wills and testaments by me heretofore made  
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day of March  
 A. D. 1842 Signed Sealed published and declared as  
 and for the last will and testament of the above
