Item 1 My will and desire is that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid out of my personal estate. Item 2 I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Maria Parsons and my household and kitchen furniture during her life time and if any thing is left there to be equally divided among all the children. And at my decease it is my desire that all the stock of Hogs cattle hogs sheep and working tools be equally divided or sold and the money equally divided among all the heirs. Item 3 I give and bequeath to my son James Parsons and Robert Parsons my son two hundred dollars notes on John L. Parsons to be paid to them equally by J. L. Parsons or to order on the notes all for it being to discontinue them and stop the said James Parsons from laying any more claims or demands against any of my lands and tenements. Item 4 It is my desire that my son Solomon Parsons and Isaac John L. Parsons should personally and immediately have their lands that I have deeded to them it being to discontinue them and stop them from laying any more claims and demands against any of my lands and tenements. Item 5 It is my desire that Stephen Jones that intermarried with my daughter Polly Parsons should have an equal share of all the proceeds of my personal estate it being to discontinue him and stop the said Stephen Jones from laying any more claims and demands against it estate.
