 This last of sales of the personal estate of James

I do solemnly swear of the County of Wrayson as hereby made my last will
 and Testament in witness whereof I give following that in every part I desire
 that the particular part of my estate be respectively used after my decease or as
 much thereof as will be sufficient to pay all my just debts and funeral expenses
 and the money arising therefrom to be applied to pay the above named debts and
 expenses should the particular part of my property prove insufficient for the above
 purposes then I desire that my Executors hereafter named may sell my
 houses and lands lying in the County of Wrayson in the State of Kentucky
 and out of the proceeds arising therefrom pay and satisfy all of my just
 debts as shall remain unpaid out of the residue of the particular part of my estate
 1st I give to my son William One Dollar, 2nd I give to my son William One
 Dollar, 3rd I give to my daughter Bethany One Dollar, 4th I give to my daughter
 Ann One Dollar, 5th I give to my daughter Andrew One Dollar, 6th I give to
 my daughter Judah One Dollar, 7th I give to my daughter Rhoda One Dollar,
 8th I give to my daughter Elizabeth One Dollar, 10th all the rest of my estate
 both real and personal of what nature or kind soever it may be not herein
 before particularly disposed of I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth
 which I give to her heirs executors administrators and assigns forever
 And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends John Cornwell and
 Andrew Cornwell Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
 all other former wills or Testaments by me heretofore made in writing whereof I have
 set my hand and affixed my seal this 27th day of June in the year of our Lord
 1846
