See schedule to and issue of the County Court of Grayson made at the November Term in 1842 The undersigned Commissioner has proceeded to sell and lay off the portion of Key's old hair and of Sam. Hair deceased in the lands of which the said Sam. Hair died seized and after taking into consideration the quantity and quality of said lands according to their nature and bounds, he came to state that they have been settled and appraised to the above lands as follows: Beginning at a point of 2000 rods above the mouth of the Spring branch and running between the fields on the north side of the creek to Sam. Parkers line; and thence around with the line of the 1000 spoken survey adjoining James Hair and Pleasant Stanton and thence to 2000 rods at a new well near the Mill and down the course of the creek to the beginning including the Missions house and all the adjoining situated on said land together with all the appurtenances thereunto appertaining. We have also proceeded to set down to the said Key's old hair, in the name of which has been had Sam. Hair and property, and he came to state that the value of the slaves of said Sam. Hair deceased according to the appraisement amounted to the sum of \$4899.50 and we settled to have our Negro Boy appraised by appraisers to \$800 and one Negro Girl named Peggy appraised to \$600 making in the whole at the above value for sum of \$1500. One third of all the slaves as well as the proceeds would amount to the sum of \$1545.00. This being the amount all that we were able to make which would have been had in the sum of \$1550.00 if getting one third of the slaves according to the price then set upon the slaves by those who appraised the personal estate of the said Sam. Hair deceased. One of which is respectfully submitted. Please under my hand & seal this 27th day of July 1843.
