Olive Hail and Elizabeth Hail. 2nd my issue is that an Inventory and appraisement be made without a sale of the property unless it is thought necessary by my executors who I shall hereafter appoint for the purpose of paying some of my Debts if there is any the use and possession of the property above mentioned by my wife is intended in her own favor. And lastly I do constitute and appoint my beloved wife Nancy Hail. Preston ^{Hail} and Francis Hail Executors and Guardians of this my Will and testament Revoking all former Wills and testaments by me made. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 12th day of January 1815.

Francis Hail and Preston Hail &c as therein named came into Court and entered into bond in the penalty of \$4000. conditioned, as the law directs and qualified according to law.
