

Grayson County State of Virginia April 20th 1835
 I Esau Worrell of the County and State aforesaid
 do hereby make my last will and Testament in manner
 and form following that is to say
 First I give to my wife Nancy Worrell the plantation
 which I now live on during her live or widow hood and to
 have one third of the profits arising there from and to be
 furnished with a good horse saddle and bridle so long as she
 may need or want one and as much of the household
 and kitchen furniture to be at her disposal, the aforesaid
 plantation my wife is to have and to hold during her widow
 hood or natural life and after her decease I give the same
 to my two sons namely Esau Worrell and Jesse Worrell to be
 Equally divided between them Esau to have Choid,
 My daughter Sally Worrell is to have one hundred acres of Land
 or one half of the Bonam tract of Land My Daughter
 Nancy Worrell is to have the Old tract of Land formerly lived on
 and an adjoining entry to George Castles Land,
 If James W. McClure is not furnished with one hundred acres of Land
 he is to have one hundred dollars when he be come of age at my
 decease all the perishable property to be immediately sold and divided
 between the Children except Esau & Jesse. According to what
 they have heretofore had so as to make them Equal,
 James W. McClure to have an Equal Share with all my Children
 Esau & Jesse Worrell to be satisfied with the Old tract of Land
 each of the tracts of Land given to the girls Estimated
 at one hundred Dollars & the boys the same all that I have
 paid over and above that amount for either of the boys
 tracts of Land they are to account for so as to make them all
 Equal, My wife Nancy Worrell is to have one half of all the
 Money and bonds for money on hand at my decease.
 She is to pay James W. McClure one hundred dollars. and
 lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Friends
 Jonathan Cook John Worrell and Esau Worrell Executors
 of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
 all other or former wills or Testament by me heretofore made
 in Writing where of I have heretofore set my hand and
 affixed my seal the day and date first above Written
 A Codicil
 I wish my wife to keep all the farming
 Manikins on the plantation with the black
 Smith tools & wheat fan during her live
 or widow hood
