This Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate of George Jones dec'd was returned to Court and ordered to be recorded

In the name of God amen, I William Pool son of Grayson County and State of Virginia being weak and low in body but of sound mind and disposing Will do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament. First I commit my body to the earth to be buried without unnecessary expence. And my soul to God who gave it. Secondly I leave unto my beloved Wife Mary Pool the plantation on which I live and all my stock of every kind during her natural life, and after her decease I give and bequeath unto my legates hereafter named. To wit: The plantation a tract of land a that part of it on which I live which is the South end of it next to my son Edward Pool and to my son Isaac Pool, to be divided between them agreeable to a conditional line named by my son Edward Pool, to them and to their heirs forever. I also give unto my son John Pool the tract of land on which he now lives to him and his heirs forever. I also give unto my son William Pool, the tract of land on which he now lives to him his heirs forever as some thinks the Grant is defective for want of the Word forever, And on the decease of my beloved wife Mary Pool I give all my stock that shall be found of every kind to my female legates also my household furniture of every kind to be equally divided among them as hereafter named To wit: Mary Bidwell, Elizabeth Hunt, Rebekah Thomas, and Nancy Pool, to them and their heirs forever. All my legates named hereof are male and female are of County and State aforesaid. And lastly I do Ordain constitute my beloved wife Mary Pool Edward Pool and John Pool my executors to this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I do hereby sign this and therewith affix my seal this 31st of October in the year of 1837.
