Item I give and bequeath unto Thomas Houns my eldest son residing in North Carolina in Randolph County All my Smith tools to him and his heirs forever Also two Pells & one Duck Coon & Spriddle one flying pan Box Iron and two Hesters.

Item I give and bequeath unto Thomas Houns aforesaid my share saddle and Bridle and my bed and bedding and all my wearing clothes Also one Wren Lifter also five powder basins and three plates to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to the above mentioned Thomas Houns all my bonds and Notes which is due to me to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lursey Hest one shilling current money of Virginia.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah Hest one shilling current money aforesaid.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Ogles one shilling current money of aforesaid.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Ogles one shilling as above said.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Roberts one shilling of the same money.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Ogles one shilling of like money.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Naomi Beck one shilling of like money.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Hercules Ogles one shilling of like money.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Hyron Ogles one shilling of like money.

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Thomas Houns aforesaid my Executor of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all other Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal this eighteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four.
