of Grayson and State of Virginia do make and ordain this my last
Will and Testament, touching such worldly Estate, as I have been formerly
seized with and first, I do ordain that all my last debts and
funeral charges be paid by my Executors hereafter mentioned 2^d I
give and bequeath to my son John Edwards one half of the tract of land
I now live on supposed to be one hundred and fifty five acres 3^d
I give and bequeath to my son Isaac Edwards the other half of
the said tract of land before mentioned, and I also give and bequeath
my son Isaac Edwards one Cow. 4th I give and bequeath to my be-
loved wife Katharine Edwards one mare two Cows and four head
of Sheep and all the household furniture to dispose of as she pleases.
I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife Katharine Edwards
the above mentioned tract of land during her widowhood of life.
And then to be divided between my two sons John & Isaac Edwards
5th And the remaining part of my Estate I leave to be sold, and
the money equally divided between all my heirs.

6th I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly Bedsatt
one Cow and two head of Sheep and one bed and furniture. And
I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my trusty son Joshua
Edwards and John Edwards Executors to my last will and testamen

In pursuance of an order of Grayson Court made at March term 1824
and an order made at December 1824 directing us to examine and
settle the accounts of Martha Curry administratrix and William
Curry, James Anderson and Joshua Stoneman administrators of
George Curry dec. we have performed that duty and beg leave to
make the following Report. It appears by an inventory and apprais-
ement of Personal in this Court that there came to the hands of the
said administrators property of their testator which according to the
said appraisement amounted to the sum of \$3320.87 1/2 cents, and
that Debts amounting to the sum of \$4290 cents due the Estate have been
collected by the said administrators. It also appears that shortly after
the death of the testator property belonging to the Estate was sold by the
said administrators at private sale for the sum of \$111.00 cents and that
on the 12th day of September 1818, other of the property was sold at Public
auction in twelve months credit for the sum of \$1283.12 1/2 cents
and that the residue of the property still remains in the hands of the
administratrix Martha Curry unsold. It also appears that the adminis-
trators have paid out and expended for Debt due from their testator
the sum of \$1441.82 1/2 cents according to the account herewith exhibited.
Vouches for a part thereof is also herewith exhibited, and notes on the
account the balance for which no vouches are produced is admitted
by the administratrix Martha Curry to have received by her since
the death of her husband.
