We the commissioners appointed by the Court of Grayson to allot unto Mollissant Morris widow of Isaac Morris dead her dower of the Lands & personal property of said Morris do allot her the following lands & personal property beginning at a Spanish oak & white oak in Gacherish Standly & then North 55° West 36 poles to a chestnut tree S. 84° W. 47° to a chestnut tree S. 4 W. 125° to a locust sapling S. 61 W. 54° to two chestnuts oaks then a strait line to the last stake mentioned in the original tract of said Morris dead then N. 24° to a large chestnut tree then N. 29 W. 115 poles to the first station also we allot to said widow 126 dollars of the personal estate of said Isaac Morris deceased the above dower found in the Court of Grayson and State of Virginia to which we set our hands this 10th day of April 1826.
