Pursuant to an order of Grayson Court I have proceeded to examine the accounts between Robert Smyth administrator of the estate of Barnet Banner Deceased and the representatives of said Banner, and find from the view of the Court, that the amount of the appraisement of said estate is ninety four Dollars & ninety five cents, And that by the oath of Elizabeth Smyth formerly wife of said Banner that Robert Smyth has her after the sale that it amounts to One hundred and between twenty one & twenty three Dollars & that Smyth was entitled to a credit of two Dollars. So I judge Robert Smyth & his securities owe to the representatives of Barnet Banner Deceased, their Debtor, One hundred & twenty one Dollars & credit by surpluses five Dollars & by the payment of two dollars leaving a balance due to said representatives of One hundred & fifteen Dollars.
