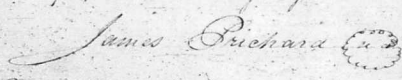


In the name of God amen. I James Richard of Grayson County and State

bequeath unto my loving Wife Jane all my Right and Title of Lands in
this State and also where and also my household furniture Emphyments of
Husbandry and Working tools also my stock every kind to her the
said Jane my wife and her heirs and assigns. I make and ordain her
to Execute of this my last Will and Testament in trust after purpose of
this my last Will and Testament. Whereof I the said James Richard have
set my hand and seal to this my last Will and Testament this sixteenth
day of June One thousand seven hundred and ninety four; Signed
sealed and delivered by the said James Richard for his last Will and
Testament in the presence of us who were present at the signing and sealing
