 I John Harris of Grayson County and State of Virginia being far advanced
 in age and being lame in body and knowing in the course of nature that my
 departure cannot be far distant, I think proper, which I am of sound mind
 and disposing memory to make this my last Will and Testament in the manner
 and following To wit: and first it is my will and desire that my son
 Jeremiah shall have the part of Lewis conveyed to him and now in his lawful
 possession except the carrying sheep which he is to give up when ever he moves his
 dwelling from this place, the land and interest of the appertenance thereto
 belonging to be his for his heirs forever. And 2^d It is my will and desire
 that my son Lewis shall have the balance of land, the tract where on he
 now lives together with the property of every description, namely and the house
 hold & Kitchen furniture plantations utensils and the stock of hogs cattle hogs
 sheep &c after my death to be his & his heirs forever, but should he choose to support
 take care of and through life & defray my funeral charges & furthermore in
 compensation of the land & property bequeathed to him I command him and his heirs
 and it is my will and desire that he (Lewis) shall pay unto my daughter Sally
 Hytton the value of two hundred & a dollar in good property at any time she may
 and he may spare or any part thereof, and after my death, before said of the land
 she may take place the balance of any to be paid in money &c it is my will and
 desire that my daughter Sally Hytton shall have a painted & adorned chest &c
 and also freely appointed Comptroller to obtain my son Jeremiah's share my
 lawful executor to this my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have

1. The agreement to and order of the County Court of Grayson to me directed &
 see the subscribers have intended the Land of Martin Dickerson and son, below
 within a Holcomb. The Brick house with five acres of Land around it
 Beginning at a stake in a line by a fence and running with the line fence
 137.8.30 poles to a stake in a line of Henry Wells on lot 9 with said Wells line
 line & 137.8.5 poles to a stake at one end of said lot on lot 133.8.11 poles to a stake
 by the road & shop, thence leaving Wells line & running with the road & 132.8.0
 poles to a stake in a field. 185.16.34 poles to the Beginning, which forms
 the first share, valued at \$1250. & will be found laid down in a plat of
 5 acres marked & 1. 1.

2. Share — The land bought of David Jones & Keith, to be divided into two
 equal parts & one half thereof a piece to be seen in that part of the place of said
 tract marked & 1. 2 together with the first lot in town Beginning at
 John Holcomb's house & 75 acres of the West ridge tract (of 400 acres) of Land
 a piece to be seen in that part of the plat of said tract of Land marked & 1. 3,
 which division line runs 137.8. to the back line & the land on Paul's creek
 to form the second share, valued at \$810. (The division line which divides the
 said tract of Land bought of Jones & Keith will be seen in a solid line in
