The Last Will and Testament of George Stanfield Deed, was presented in Court and proven by Horon Wills and James Jones Subscribing Witnesses and ordered to be Recorded and Isaac Edwards and Edward Jones Executors therein named came in to Court and Entered into and acknowledged Their Bond with Sabey Johnson and Matthew Dillards their Sureties in the sum of Eight hundred Dollars with conditions as the law directs and qualified according to law. I Jeremiah Stone of the County of Grayson Bezzing in Perfect Health  
I stone and of sound mind and of a disposing mind memory and calling  
to mind the uncertainty of human life and being desirous to dispose  
of all such worldly estate as I have in possession. First I give and  
bequeath in manner and form following that I desire that all my just  
Dots be paid after my decease and I wish the Remaining part of my real  
and personal Estate to be Equally divided between my Children Namely -  
William Stone Stephen Stone John Stone Betsy Hail Lucy Hail Maryah  
Stone Nancy Hambleton Richard Stone and Jeremiah Stone and Lastly  
I do hereby constitute and appoint Stephen Stone and William Hail  
Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other  
or former wills or testaments by me here before made In witness whereof I  
have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 17<sup>th</sup> Day of
