Payson Lake Office 2nd September 1830 This Inventory and appraisement of
 Matthew Dickson Esq. was presented and admitted to Record. Test Mr. Dickerson Esq.
 I John Lundy Sr. of the County of Payson and State of
 Virginia being weak in body but of sound mind and
 memory considering my age do this day make ordain and
 constitute this my last will and testament in form and
 manner following Viz

I term first I give and devise unto my beloved wife Rebecca
 Lundy My Plantation house and premises wherein I now live
 for and during her natural life or widowhood to be laid off in
 the following manner beginning at a white oak sapling corner
 to Amos Lundy's survey then south 44 West with said survey
 poles to two Red oaks North 27 West 66 poles to the old Little
 River Road and with the several courses thereof till it intersects
 the old patent line and with the same to the Beginning contain
 ing sixty acres by estimation be the same more or less and
 after my beloved wife's decease or second marriage I give
 and devise the aforesaid Land and Premises unto my
 Daughter Rachael Lundy to be freely enjoyed by her
 and her heirs forever. I term second I give and devise
 unto my son Amos Lundy all the remainder parts of the aforesaid
 tract of land lying on the south west side of Little River old road
 to be freely enjoyed by him and his heirs forever. Thirdly I give
 and devise unto my seven children hereafter named Viz Ruth
 Lundy Sharon Lundy Joann Lundy Anna Lundy Lewis Lundy and
 Eliza Lundy each of them on dollar to be paid in common
 made out of my estate by my executors hereafter named. Fourthly my
 will is that all my just debts be paid out of my estate by
 my executors hereafter named. Fifthly I give and bequeath to my
 Daughter Rachael old year old mare sold to be freely enjoyed
 by her and her heirs forever. Sixthly I give and bequeath
 unto my beloved wife Rebecca Lundy all the Residue of my personal
 Property of every species whatsoever to be freely enjoyed by herself
 for and during her natural life or widowhood and to be disposed
 after her decease as she may think proper. Seventh my will
 is that my wife is that thereby appoint constitute and name
 ate my friends William Bartlett and my friend Ezra Stuckler
 to be my Executors of my Last will and testament truly
 Revoking and annulling and declaring void all former wills

I Thomas Hall of the county of Grayson and state of Virginia being
in a low state of health but of a sound mind and disposition hereby
make known to man this my last will and testament in a manner for
following Next first it is my will and desire that as much of my property
bequeathed such as can best be spared as will pay all my just debts
and buy my Daughter Eliza a dress for her particular attention
to me and be disposed of according by Executors herein after named
2^d It is my will and desire that my beloved wife Anne should enjoy all
the best of my Estate both real and personal during her natural or
widowhood and after her death the Balance of my estate Except the
land be so disposed of as will make my three youngest daughters with
the two eldest that had already received a bequest some household and
furniture a chest and cotton wheel a piece and the Balance of any Equity
Divided amongst all my daughters Anna Martha Eliza Polly Frances
3rd It is my will and desire that the land with its appurtenances
should be equally divided amongst or enforced authority by my sons
Sankfort Thomas John & Charles in consequence of which of them should
not be enough purchasable property to make these youngest daughters Equal
with the two eldest the above named sons shall bear an Equal part
in making them equal and 4th lastly I do hereby constitute and
ordain my son Sankfort Hall & Peter Monroe my sole and true Executors to
this my last will and testament. The witness hereof have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 2^d day of August 1827

Grayson September Court 1827

This last will and Testament of Thomas Hall does was
presented in Court and proven by Charles Dehaven & Abraham Dehaven
subscribing witnesses and ordered to be recorded And Sankfort Hall & Peter
Monroe Executors therein named came into Court and entered into bond
with Thomas Baldwin & James Monroe their securities in the penalty of
Two hundred Dollars with obligations as the law directs and took the
oath of Executors whereupon a certificate is granted them in due form
of law

This procuring of an order of Court made at June Term 1827 directing us
to examine the estate and settle the account of Edward Jones and Isaac Edwards Executors
of George Springfield Dece. We have proceeded on the 28th day of August 1827
at the dwelling house of James Anderson in the County of Grayson (after
being duly sworn to perform that duty) to make the following
report. It appears that the Executors after distributing the specific legacies
mentioned in the Will they were then in possession of property debts & money
contained in a list including a tract of land which has been returned
with the Clerk's office and recorded amounting to the sum of three hundred
Dollars forty nine Dollars, property & land sold part on the 6th day of Septem
ber 1827 and the balance on the seventh of the same month there also
appears to have come in to the Executors a note on James Jones for five
Dollars One D^r on John H. Caudle part of which was paid the balance is
One Dollar & forty two cents a balance of a note on Aaron Ritter
of One Dollar & fifty cents also a receipt from Eli Harvey for seventy
Dollars which notes & receipts has not yet been collected there is
deficient other legacies named in the will for money which has not been
settled and the Executors having produced vouchers to the amount of
seventy nine Dollars nine Dime fourth cents which taken from the above
sum of three hundred and forty nine Dollars there is a balance
in the hands of two hundred and sixty nine Dollars nine & three fourth
cents
