I John Starr of Virginia, being far advanced in age and being feeble and becoming in the same. I declare, that my departing, cannot be far distant, I think proper, while I am of sound mind and disposing memory to make this my last Will and Testament in the manner and following To wit: and first it is my will and desire that my son Jeremiah shall have the part of Land surveyed to him and now in his father's papers except the Cuying's shop which he is to give up when ever he moves his dwelling from this place, the land acc thereto of the appearance of the woods belonging to be his & his heirs forever. And 2^d It is my will and desire that my son Levin Starr shall have the balance of Land, the tract where on he now lives together with the property of every acre there, namely acc the home hold & Kitchen furniture plantations ulcers acc the stock of Horses cattle hogs sheep &c after my death to be his & his heirs forever, but shall be bound to support take care of me through life & defray my funeral charge & furthermore in Compensation of the Land & property bequeathed to him I consider Just & Right and it is my will and desire that he (Levin) shall pay out to my daughter Sally Hyllon the value of two hundred Dollars in good property at any time she may and he may spare or any part thereof, and after my death, let the sale of the Land there take place, the balance of any to be paid in money &c It is my will and desire that my daughter Sally Hyllon shall have a painted & decorated Chest &c and she shall appoint, constitute & ordain my son Jeremiah Starr my lawful Executor to this my last Will & Testament. The contents whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day and date above written.
