I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife Katharine Edwards the above mentioned tract of land during her widowhood at life. And then to be divided between my two sons John & Isaac Edwards 5<sup>th</sup> And the remaining part of my Estate I leave to be sold, and the money equally divided between all my heirs. 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Polly Bedsatt one Cow and two head of Sheep and one bed and furniture. And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my trusty son Joshua Edwards and son Isaac Edwards Executors to my last will and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February one thousand eight hundred and twenty five signed sealed in the presence of

In pursuance of an order of Grayson Court made at March term 1824 and an order made at December 1824 directing us to examine and settle the accounts of Martha Curry administratrix and William Currier, James Anderson and Joshua Stoneman administrators of George Currier dec. we have performed that duty and beg leave to make the following Report. It appears by an inventory and appraisement of Personal in this Court that there came to the hands of the said administrators property of their testator which according to the said appraisement amounted to the sum of \$3320.87 1/2 cents, and that Debts amounting to the sum of \$4290 cents due the Estate have been collected by the said administrators. It also appears that shortly after the death of the testator property belonging to the Estate was sold by the said administrators at private sale for the sum of \$111.00 cents and that on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September 1818, other of the profits was sold at Public auction on twelve months credit for the sum of \$1283.12 1/2 cents and that the residue of the property still remains in the hands of the administratrix Martha Curry widowed. It also appears that the administrators have paid out and expended for Debts due from their testator the sum of \$1441.82 1/2 cents according to the account herewith exhibited. Vouchers for a part thereof is also herewith exhibited, and noted on the account the balance for which no vouchers are produced is admitted by the administratrix Martha Curry to have received by her since the death of her husband.
