Secondly I give to my dear and loving Wife Peggy the dwelling house wherein I now live with all the furniture thereunto belonging and all the stock together with all the Land and improvements there about it, for and during her natural life or Widowhood, and that she have power at her discretion to contribute any part of my estate to any of my Children as she shall think proper and After her decease or intermarriage, I do give and direct all my Estate both Real and personal Estate to be equally divided amongst my Children to wit, Luchiey, Polly, John, James & Thomas. Lastly I do constitute and appoint my loving wife Peggy Phillips Executrix and Sole Executor of this my last Will and testament.
