the mortality of my body and knowing that it
is appointed for all men once to die do make
and ordain this my Last Will and Testament
that is to say principally and first of all I give
and Recommend my soul unto the hand of
almighty God that gave it and my body I recom-
mend to the earth to be buried in decent Chris-
tian Burial at the discretion of my executors
Nothing doubting but at the general resur-
rection I shall Receive the same again by the
mighty power of God And as touching such worldly
Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless
me in this life I give devise and dispose of
the same in the following manner and form
first my desire is that all of my Just debts

and funeral Expenses be paid Secondly I give and bequeath unto my be loved wife Maryann all my personal Estate only such thing or thing as herein mentioned during her Natural life and if she should have a child within nine months that is Legitimate Lawful heir to my Land one third of my estate but if no heir thereby I give unto my father all my farming tools utensils and fourthly I give unto my beloved mother one cow and fifthly I give and bequeath unto my beloved Brother Stephen Thomas all my Lands tenements Sixthly I give and bequeath unto son doolph Thomas one gun barrel. I take wise Constables and appoint and ordain Jonathan Thomas and Joseph Fields the sole Executors of this my Last will and Testament all and Singular my Lands messuages and tenements by them freely to be possessed and enjoyed by them and his hereby utterly disavow Revocate and annul all and Every other former testament Will Bequest or Executors by me in any wise before named uttered and bequeathed Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25 day June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen sealed & Signed in the presents of
