the Estate of John Robinson Dec. 9 with Andrew Robinson administrator of said
Estate, have presented this 7 day of November 1835 to perform the same and
by leave to make the following report.
It appears to your honorship, that there came into the hands of the
Administrator by the amount of sales entered on the records in the Clerk's office
of the County Court of Longwood
the sum of \$ 1677 43 1/2
Also there came into the hands of the said Administrator notes and
accounts to the amount of \$ 166 33 1/2
and cash to the amount of \$ 435 50
Amounting in the whole to the sum of \$ 3300 75 1/2
And the said Court presented sundry claims and accounts against
the said estate which he had discharged, to wit: one in favor of himself \$ 550 00
"Specimen account in favor of J. Brown" 16 00
"Do in favor of John Clement" 15 00
"Do in favor of Joshua Stoneman" 8 16 1/2
