In the name of God Amen I John Lewis Jr of the County of Grayson and State of Virginia being very weak in body but of perfect mind memory thanks be given unto God calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testamant that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hand of all mighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the direction of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate wherewithal I have pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form First I make & appoint Spencer Lewis & Samuel Hart to be my executors & Executrix of this my last will and testament all my just debts to be paid in the just place and my Estate to be divided as follows: To my son Spencer Lewis I give and bequeath two hundred & fifteen acres of land known by the mill on Bear Creek joining Ichabod Belknap's land in three tracts of land all belonging to my son Hugh Lewis I give and bequeath this tract of land where I now live and one other tract joining the two tracts containing two hundred acres one hundred acres also to my wife Charity Lewis I give and bequeath all the property that I have as long as she does suffice for to raise and support my children and the land that I left to my son Hugh Lewis as long as she lives a widow and if she marries then for her to have an equal share with my four daughters in the property and that to be sold by my executors & Executrix equally divided amongst them and I doth seal no sale of no property I have except my wife Charity remains a widow I do hereby utterly disclaim all and every right to this property Testamentary wills legacies bequests & testaments by me in any wise before named testifies and bequeathes ratifying and confirming this in no other to be my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty three signed sealed and delivered by the said John Lewis Jr his last will and testament in the presence of John Young who in his presence signed & was in the presence of each of these have hereunto subscribed my names
