I James Cornutt of Grozon County do hereby make my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say:
 1st I desire that all my just debts be paid out of the perishable part of my Estate. 2nd after the payment of my debts and funeral expenses I give to my wife Molly Cornutt one third part of my Estate both real and personal for and during her natural life and if my perishable property should prove more than sufficient to pay my just debts I desire that my wife should have the over plus during her natural life. 3rd I give to my son Archelus all my home tract of land that I now live on together with all its appurtenances and also a Survey that I bought of Col. Dickinson of 100 Acres more or less & I desire that Archelus should have full and peaceable possession after the death of his mother. 4^{thly} I give to the Children of my Daughter Melly namely Polly James and Rhoda & Angeline one Equal share of my Perishable property to be Equally Divided amongst them three by my Executors at the arrival of lawful age. 5^{thly} I give to my sons John & Lape Cornutt the tract of land I bought of Elias Price for them to have & to hold forever & I wish Reuben & John to mark off the constitutional line between John & Lape as was contemplated betwix Reuben & John. 6^{thly} I wish all my personal property after my just debts is paid & after the death of my wife to be Equally divided amongst all my Children and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends William & Archelus Cornutt Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others or former wills heretofore by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this April the 22nd 1824
