

Inventary of the Estate of William Beason in the State of Virginia

A receipt of Rosanna Keller in the County of Patrick for 93 $\frac{3}{4}$  lbs coffee & 30 lbs 73 lbs of sugar at 15 cents per pound & twenty (20) lbs cotton & 200 lbs per pound which she was to sell & account for at three prices which receipt is credited by \$12,760. Leaving a balance of \$22,91 $\frac{1}{4}$  the above appears to be disparted

A receipt on John Scott of Patrick for 61 $\frac{1}{4}$  cotton & 20 lbs to be sold & accounted for by him or returned when called for \$12,25

A receipt on John Scott of Patrick for 20 crocks 2 Pitchers 12 Dishes 10 cups 46 Pipes 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  cotton amounting to \$13,755 cents to sell or return with a credit of 3 lbs 100g shootlines \$6,100g tallow 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs 100g tallow but ought to be bees wax & 4 bushels hats the credit amounting to \$4,933 $\frac{1}{4}$  cents leaving a balance of \$8,821 $\frac{3}{4}$  cents

A receipt on Joshua Haynes of Patrick for 36 crocks 15 Pitchers 7 cups 32 Dishes & pans 13 Pans 6 plates 1 chamber pot 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs coffee 16 lbs steel to sell or return when called for to be amounting to \$30,68 cents

A receipt on John Kerns for 22 lbs steel to sell or return amounting to \$5,50 which receipt is credited \$150 cents leaving a balance of \$4

A Receipt on Thomas Moore for 14 crocks 24 Pitchers 2 Dishes 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  Dishes & Pans 20 cups 1 chamber pot 100 Pipes 5 lbs powder 56 lbs of coffee bag & all the baggage left in retailing 7 lbs red wax amounting to \$49,277 $\frac{1}{4}$  cents which receipt is credited by 202 cents of leaving three 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs shootlines 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs bees wax amounting 22 dollars 30 cents leaving a balance of \$26,907 $\frac{1}{4}$  cents
