S. And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I do Ordain give and dispose of the same in manner and form following that is to say: First I will that all those Debts and dues as I owe in Right and conscience to any manner of Person whatsoever shall be well and truly contented and paid: within convenient time after my decease by my Executors hereafter named -

Next I give and bequeath to Fanny my wife whom I nominate my Executor her choice of Beds one Chair and all the Moveables and money to be equally divided between my wife and William whom also I appoint as Executor them two Jenny Robb Annama Brinkley except ten shillings a piece that is to say ten shillings to Tom East ten shillings to Sarah Polyparts ten shillings to Mary Linable ten shillings to Elizabeth Biles ten shillings to Martha Jones, In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this ninth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and nineteenth
