Sixthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Catharine and her Heirs forever all
my land and tithes in and to Holy Cross & Land being and being in the County
of Wythe in the State of New River Also all my personal Estate & every exception
including my Stock & all kinds household furniture and every species of property that
now belongs to me to her and her Heirs Executors and Administrators or assigns forever.

Lastly I appoint my trusty friend James Sage Executor of this my last Will and
Testament hereby revoking all others or former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore
