 my money three Cows with calf four ten head of great Cows of my hog, twelve head of
 the great Cows of my sheep & other Birds, stock & furniture & as much of my household
 furniture in she chooses to keep & I give unto my dear daughter Lydia all that belong to her
 unto during her widowhood & I give unto my eldest son John Roberts the sum of One dollar
 fifty dollars & no more. & I give unto my son William Roberts the sum of One dollar, fifty
 and no more. & I give unto my son James Roberts the sum of One dollar, fifty
 I give unto my son Jonathan Roberts the sum of One dollar. & I give unto my
 son David Roberts One dollar & no more. & I do also give unto my two sons
 Haden B. & Asahel Roberts my houses & lands that I now live on to be equally
 divided between the two I do also bequeath the same unto the said Haden B. & Asahel
 Roberts for ever the claim or claim of any person or persons whatsoever by their
 paying unto John B. Roberts & Eliza Ann Roberts the sum of fifty dollars
 each, say twenty five dollars to each, when they may or they shall demand

before they are of lawful age & in case they do not marry the 50 dollars to each when they arrive at lawful age. I give to the said Judson B. Roberts and his wife and son Sally, One good Cow with calf, One Bed & furniture and bedding goods. I give unto the said Zachariah Roberts, One Horse, One good Cow & calf, One good Bed & furniture, One good Hog. I give unto my daughter Jonathan's Pool the sum of Eight dollars & I give unto Sally Porter the sum of One dollar. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Harkler the sum of thirteen dollars. I also give to Phile B. Roberts the sum of One hundred and seven dollars, including the above named sum of fifty dollars which Judson B. Roberts & Zachariah Roberts is to pay as first a bond mentioned out of the price of the land, also One Cow with calf, One good Bed and furniture. I do also give unto my youngest daughter Eliza Ann Roberts the sum of 57 Dollars, One Cow & calf One Bed worth twenty dollars together with fifty dollars which my son Judson B. Roberts & Zachariah Roberts is to pay as first a bond mentioned out of the price of the land and after paying to each legatee the above named sum severally out of the remaining part of my personal property after paying my just debt & funeral expenses, I desire that the remainder should be sold & equally divided amongst my five daughters, viz. Fostiana Good, Sally Porter, Elizabeth Harkler & Eliza Ann Roberts. I also desire that it is my will that if any one of my heirs or heirs should attempt in law to break this my last Will & testament that they should be each of them with One dollar. I then part to be equally divided amongst the balance of my heirs.
