

533 I James Farmer do hereby make my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first I desire that so much of the perishable part my Estate be immediately sold after my decease as will pay all my just debts and funeral expenses and after the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses I desire that my wife Susannah Farmer do have and enjoy my plantation where I now live during his natural life with all the Rest of my estate both Real and personal and after the decease of my wife I give to my Daughter Elizabeth the plantation on which I now live with her share of the negro boys and also I give my 2^d Daughter the negro woman Molly the 2^d plantation Negro boy and negro woman I give to my above named Daughter and I give to my son James my plantation known by the name of the Old place and I give to my son Isaac the plantation on which he now lives and has settled and my plantation known by the lower place I give to my three sons Michael Isaac and James to be Equally Divided between the three and I desire that my plantation known by the name of the Hill place be sold and Rebecca Newman my Daughter to have all the money arising from the sale except fifteen dollars which I give to my 2^d grand Daughter Lenora Farmer I also give to my 2^d grand Daughter a note of hand of nine dollars which I hold on Barnet Farmer and after the death of my wife I give to Lydia Courtman Daughter of John and Lydia Courtman one hundred dollars and the money which I sent by my son Michael to by Land in the west Irish to be equally divided between my my three sons above named, or the Land with the money purchases and all the Remains of part of my estate I desire to be Equally divided between my several Children. Lastly I do constitute and appoint my son Isaac Farmer and my friend John Vaughn Executors to this my last will and testament as witness my hand and seal January 15th 1836.
