We the undersigned being called on Saturday morning February 10 1844 into the presence of John Beazley then lying in his death bed, and being unable to write, and supposing him to die, yet of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby certify the following to be the last Will of the said John S. Beazley delivered to us verbally on said morning to wit: That his wife Frances should take of his estate and property that portion to which she shall be entitled by law, and of the remainder his full brother Robert G. Beazley should have two thirds, and his half brother Fourkin James should take the remaining third: and furthermore that he wished his half sisters Elizabeth J. J. and Kitty Anna whatever to have no portion of his estate whatever.

In testimony of the above we have hereunto set our hands this the 15th of Feb'y 1844.
