

This day came the parties by their attorneys and thereupon the transcript of the record of the judgment aforesaid being seen and inspected, and every witness being sworn and examined and the parties fully heard, it is considered by the Court, that the judgment aforesaid be affirmed and that the appellant recover against the appellee his costs by him expended as well in the said County Court as in defending the appeal aforesaid here, and it is ordered that the said writ be recorded in the Case Writs and Testament of the said William Dulaney deceased and in the return of John G. Dulaney an executor thereon named, who made oath thereto according to law, and together with John Barton and William Enley his securities who imposed upon oath as to their sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Fifty Thousand Dollars, conditioned as the law directs. Custodian is granted them for a further thereof in due form.
