interest coming to me from my father's estate to my Brother
George Ed Blakely - I also give my horse Coll + Cow and all
of my household + kitchen furniture to my Brother George
Ed Blakely - I desire my Brother George E Blakely to sell my
carriage + use the money in furnishing the parsonage in
Athensville - This is my last will + testament written
with my own hand this the 22nd day of April 1869 -
Virginia D Blakely

In the Circuit Court of Greene County the 17th of November
1869 this last will and testament of Virginia D Blakely
was proved by the oath of A D Almond, who testified
that the said ~~document~~ will as well as the signature was
wholly in the hand writing of the testatrix, and was
ordered to be recorded - and on motion of Geo Ed Blakely
on the 18th of Nov 1869, who made oath thereto and together
with Leiza B McMullen security who justified as to her
sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a Bond in
the penalty of six hundred dollars conditioned according
to law certificates is granted here for taking letters of
administration on the estate of said testatrix with her
said will annexed in due form of Law -
