Greenville September 6th 1801. This Will was proved by the oath of Samuel
Johnson a witness thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of
Bolling Chambliss one of the Executors therein named who made oath thereto
and with Lucy Chambliss his security entered into and acknowledged Bond
in the penalty of Five Thousand Dollars with condition as the Law directs
Certificate was granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.
