 Estate to be left in the manner and form as followeth, that is to
 say I lend to my dear beloved wife Elizabeth Davis during her
 life or my widow, all my Negroes namely ^{a Man named} Frank and a Woman
 named Hannah and a boy named Peter and all of my Stock of
 each sort and Household and Kitchen furniture and for her to
 keep the Children and give them Schooling and after the death
 of my wife for fifty Dollars to be raised out of the Estate for
 Patsy Read and then the balance to be equally divided between my
 two Children without a sale, Elizabeth ^{Davis} my wife and Timothy

All I have Given to this my last Will and Testament revoking

I Man named
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named Hannah and a boy named Peter and all of my stock of
each sort and Household and Kitchen furniture and for her to
keep the Children and give them Schooling and after the death
of my wife for Fifty Dollars to be raised out of the Estate for
Patsy Read and then the balance to be equally divided between my
two Children without a sale, Elizabeth ^{Davis} my wife and Timothy
Allen I leave Executor to this my last Will and Testament revoking
all other Wills made by me heretofore made in witness whereof
unto set my Hand and seal this 25th November 1803.
