Rania, Judah, Lucy, to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and
bequeath to my Son Burgess as aforesaid all my Lands and all my stock
of Horses and cattle and Hogs with all my House hold furniture of all
kinds now in my possession, likewise all the crops of Corn &c. Item
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betsy Little, six Negroes, Namely, Sarah,
Tom, Annica, Sylvia, Jacob, Sam, to her and her coposal &c. Item I wish
my desire that Burgess Bass my Son as aforesaid do pay all my just debts
of all kinds whatever that may come against my Estate, And this being the
