I Catherine Harris of the County of Greenville and State of Virginia do make this my last Will & Testament as touching such Worldly Goods and Estate as providence hath put into my hands I dispose of in the following manner (viz) I desire that all my just Debts may be punctually paid out of any estate which I direct to be sold hereafter And the balance of my Estate I give in the following manner First I give my wearing Apparel to be Equally Divided between my three Daughters namely Jane & Wil		

Harris, Betsey Pennington, and Anna Patrick, Secondly, I give my negro man Aaron to Eliza
 Webb who married my Grand Daughter Betsey Harris, I also give the said Ann & Eliza
 Webb five Pounds to assist in maintaining the said negro Aaron Thirdly, I give my
 Great Grand Daughters (the youngest Daughter of Anna Harris by her husband Ben-
 jamin) and the grand Daughters of my son Isaac Harris, the bed and furniture, & trappings
 thereto belonging that I usually use and being small and. Fourthly, I give that my Ex-
 ecutors do sell all the rest of my Estate of my kind and whosoever to the highest bidder and
 six months credit Fifthly After my Debts and funeral expenses are paid, I give to Eliza
 Harris my great grand son fifty Dollars for the purpose of giving him some English Educa-
 tion And I appoint my grand son Benjamin Harris his Guardian for the above purpose
 Sixthly, I give to my two great grand sons, James & Richard Harris (Who are Brothers to the
 above named Elias Harris) twenty Dollars each, to assist in their Education And the above
 money to be put into the hands of Benjamin Harris above mentioned for the said pur-
 pose. Seventhly, I give after the above legacies be paid, that the money of my
 personal Estate be divided into two parts an Equal Share. One Share of which I give
 to be Equally divided among the surviving Daughters of my son Lyden deceased And
 the other Share, or half I give to be equally divided among the surviving Children of

The other I have, or half I give to be equally divided among the surviving Children of
my Son David Harris deceased. Eightiethly, And lest there should any Doubt arise re-
specting my estate herein left to be sold, I do particularly intend that all my Negroes (ex-
cept old Bonard) be sold; namely, Sam, Lucy, Ben, Young Bonard, Allan, and Mary, these four
last mentioned negroes being the children of Lucy, and any other increase the said Lucy may have
before the Day of Sale as well as all my personal Estate not given here before I have the whole
of the said Estate to be sold as before directed. Ninetiethly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my
friend Col^d Charles Harrison of Northampton in North Carolina Who is Uncle to two of the
Legates, and Benj^d Gowing who married my Grand Daughter Lady Harris Executors to this my
last Will & Testament signed sealed and acknowledged for all the above purposes This
twenty third Day of April One thousand Eight hundred and ten.
