 hereafter mentioned thinks proper, to share or to make sale of. Item I give unto Edwin Bond
 my Nephew one hundred Dollars to be raised out of my Estate when he arrives to the age of
 Twenty years to him and his heirs forever. Item I give unto my Niece Dolly or Dorothy
 Matham fifty dollars to be raised out of my Estate when she arrives to the age of Eighteen

361/ years to her and her heirs forever. Lastly I give and bequeath ^{un} to my loving wife Polly Clarke after paying my debts and the above legacies ^{and Virginia pioneers.net} all my estate both real and personal to her and her heirs forever. In Testimony whereof I constitute and appoint my dear and loving wife executing and John Richard executor to this my last will and Testament. Revoking all others heretofore made by me, and in consideration of the trouble the said John Richard will have in the business I give him the sum of one hundred dollars to be raised out of my Estate instead of the fees he is lawfully entitled to & in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 28th day of July one thousand eight hundred, & Twelve.
