In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1811. Elizabeth Dupree LS.

Signed, sealed, published and delivered by the above named Elizabeth Dupree to be her last will and Testament in the presence of us who her request in her presence have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses to the same.

At a Court held for Greensville County the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1811. This will was proved by the oath of Samuel Francis a Witness thereto and ordered to be Recorded. and on the motion of Henry Dupree the Executor therein named who made oath thereto and together with Lewis Dupree his Security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the said court Certificate has granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form.
