Greensville County, Virginia Wills, Book 2, 1806 to 1816  
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In the name of God Amen. Elizabeth Dupree of Greensville County Virginia being of sound and free  
mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form  
following that is to say I give and bequeath unto my Son Henry Dupree the whole of my Estate of  
what kind or nature soever, whom I hereby appoint sole Executor of this my last will and Testament  
hereby revoking all former wills made by me. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
Seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1814. Elizabeth Dupree ES!

Signed, sealed, published and declared by the above  
named Elizabeth Dupree to be her last will and  
Testament in the presence of us who after request  
in her presence have hereunto subscribed our names  
as witnesses to the same.

At a Court held in Greensville County the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1816. This will was proved by the  
oath of Samuel Francis a Witness thereto and ordered to be Recorded, and on the motion of Henry  
Dupree the Executor therein named who made oath thereto and together with Lewis Dupree his  
Security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars condi-  
tioned as the said assets Certificate was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form.
